

Mandatory questions for the application for the Libertas Support Fund

Introductory question on statement form:

- How can you show that you were politically active in your home country?

Help questions for statement form:

- Are you part of an organization or group that seeks to improve the political situation? If so, what is the group's name and what does it stand for? (What documents can be produced to show this?)
- Have you taken part in events, marches or demonstrations? If so, which ones and what was the purpose and outcome of these? (What documents, news articles, etc. can be produced to show this?)
- Have your activities actually resulted in your study progress being made difficult or impossible? If so, in what way were things made difficult or impossible and what was the effect? (What documents, e.g. notice of suspension, can be produced to show this?)
- If you have answered no to these questions, why do you think you should be eligible for the Libertas Support Fund?

Studies:

- What higher education institution were you last enrolled at (give completion dates or study duration).
- When did you stop your studies as a result of your activities? What documents can be produced to show this (e.g. notice of suspension)? Did you appeal against your suspension? If so, what happened with the appeal? If not, why not?
- What documents can be added to the application to further explain your choice of study programme and higher education institution, or to make the admission process easier? This applies for all study programmes.
